

ORDINANCE 1367


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 307 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GIRARD PERTAINING TO OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.

Section 1. Permit for sale of fireworks required; fee; issuance.

- a) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, display for sale, offer to sell or give away any type of fireworks within the city without first paying a permit fee of \$200 per establishment or premises. Payment shall be made to the city clerk. Application and payment must be made on or before June 25th of the permit year. Groups or organizations selling fireworks in order to raise funds for Girard community organizations or activities shall pay a reduced fee of \$100 per establishment and shall provide documentation proving that funds raised were deposited into an account associated with a tax-exempt community organization and the organization's IRS Form W-9.
- b) Prior to the issuance of the permit, an inspection shall be made of the applicant's establishment or premises for compliance with this chapter and other Federal and State Laws and City Ordinances. A permit shall not be issued for any establishment or premises not in compliance with such laws or ordinances. The Applicant shall be required to carry liability insurance for a minimum of \$2,000,000.00 with proof to the City Clerk on or before June 25th of the permit year. Upon qualifying for the permit, the permittee shall prominently display the same at the establishment or premises where fireworks are to be sold or displayed for sale. The permit fee shall not be refundable upon failure to qualify for the permit or withdrawal or cancellation of the application or permit.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication according to law.
