Council President Darrell Westhoff:


Thanks, public works director and his staff for all the work they are doing. Election is tomorrow and we need others to get out and vote.

Mayor Mickey Pyle:


Eco's what everyone else said. Thanks to all the employees. Get out and voting tomorrow it's important.
