


ORDINANCE NO. 1323

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GIRARD, KANSAS BY AMENDING SECTION 210 AND PERTAINING TO DANGEROUS OBJECTS IN THE STREETS.


SECTION 1. DANGEROUS AND DAMAGING OBJECTS IN.

- (a) It shall be the duty of every person owning or occupying any lot or parcel of land adjoining any public or private alley in the city to keep the same clean and in an inoffensive condition, and also keep the gutter in front, behind, or beside the premises free from filth or other offensive matter, including, but not limited to, landscape waste or leaves, that may prevent the free flow of water therein.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to place, throw or cause to be placed or thrown in or on any street, alley, sidewalk or other public grounds of the city, any glass, tacks, nails, bottles, wire or other dangerous objects that might wound any person or animal, or cut or puncture any pneumatic tire while passing over the same.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for any property owner, occupant or any person working for hire or as a volunteer to place, rake, or blow any leaves or landscape waste, including grass, onto the streets or in any of the public street gutters adjoining the property owned, occupied or at which a person is working for hire or as a volunteer.
- (d) Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this section shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of no less than \$20 for each offense.
